

- · This budget is <u>very conservative</u> and is based on what was known at the time the budget was being developed.
- · A final 2023-24 budget package has not been signed yet, so this budget is based largely on the Governor's "May Revise" budget proposal.
- · If there are any material changes to the budget, they will be presented as a "45-Day Revision" or and "August Budget."


2023-2024 GENERAL FUND REVENUE



- <u>General Purpose</u> Property Taxes, EPA. State Aid
- <u>Federal</u> District must follow specific guidelines (Title I, Title II, Federal COVID funds, etc.)
- Other State State funds not part of LCFF Calculation (Lottery, Special Education, State COVID funds, etc.)
- <u>Local</u> Funds received from local sources (Interest, Donations, etc.)

In the 2023-2024 budget, salaries and benefits comprise approximately **57.99%** of total budgeted expenditures (**85.99%** of Unrestricted budgeted expenditures)

MYP ASSUMPTIONS

- · Projected budgets assume that trend of declining enrollment will continue at a rate of 50 students per year.
- · Budget for 2023-24 Certificated Salaries reflects the recent settlement with WEA.
- · Salary projections include a 2.0% increase for step/column advancements and no other pay increase.
- · Benefits projections include a 2.0% increase for anticipated increase in benefit rates.
 - · Projections include estimated rates for PERS/STRS

- · Monitor budgets regularly to keep an eye on spending and to work on increasing level of General Fund fund balance.
- · Look at ways to address history of deficit spending and structural deficit issues.
- · Monitor spending from one-time revenue sources and make adjustments if/when needed.
- · Incorporate additional revenues/expenditures into district budget once the fiscal effects of the budget package are known and final figures are released by CDE.
- · Begin preliminary work on 2022-23 Unaudited Actuals.
