Notice is hereby given that on September 15, 2022 at approximately 5:00 PM at the regular meeting of its Governing Board, Wright Elementary School District ("District") will conduct a public hearing regarding the sufficiency of textbooks and/or instructional materials in order to comply with the requirements of Education Code Section 60119.

As discussed at the August 18, 2022, Board meeting, the Board determined and took action that, in accordance with Government Code section 54953(e)(3), the state of emergency associated with COVID-19 continues to directly impact the ability of the Board members to meet safely in person. Therefore, while the public cannot attend the meeting in-person, the public can still view the meeting live and make public comment during the meeting. The governing board encourages participation by parents, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders in the public hearing.

The definition of "sufficient textbooks and/or instructional materials" means that each student, including each English learner, has standards-aligned textbooks and/or instructional materials to use in class and/or to take home, which may include materials in a digital format but shall not include photocopies sheets from only a portion of a textbook and/or instructional materials copies to address a shortage.

Textbooks and/or instructional materials in core curriculum subjects should be aligned with state academic content standards adopted by the State Board of Education pursuant to Education Code 60605 and/or the Common Core State Standards adopted pursuant to Education Code 60605.8.

The Hearing will be open to the public. At any time before that date and time set forth in this notice for the Public Hearing, written comment on the proposal may be filed at the District Office, 4385 Price Ave, Santa Rosa, CA. All persons wishing to comment at the public hearing will be given an opportunity to be heard.
