These vaccination clinics are Mobile Van Clinics conducted by Curative. No advance registration is required except for youth under 18 attending without a parent or guardian.



Parental Consent Required for Students Under 18

Students under age 18 must have signed parental consent.

Youth attending without a parent or guardian must complete an online registration/consent form in advance.
